Ephesians Scripture Week Ten

Jn. 14:19 After a little while the world will no longer see Me, but you will see Me; because I live, you will live also. In that day you will know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you...23 "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our abode with him.

Jn. 17:22 The glory which You have given Me I have given to them, that they may be one, just as We are one; I in them and You in Me, that they may be perfected in unity, so that the world may know that You sent Me, and loved them, even as You have loved Me.

Col. 1:27 To them God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles are the riches of the glory of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

Rom. 8:9 However, you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you.

1 Cor. 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.

1 Jn. 4:13 By this we know that we abide in Him and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit.

Rom. 8:10 But if Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the Spirit is alive because of righteousness.

Col. 3:3 For you have died and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ, who is our life, is revealed, then you also will be revealed with Him in glory.

Eph. 1:4 even as He chose us *in Him* before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before Him. In love

1 Cor. 15:22 For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ all shall be made alive.

Rom. 8:38 For I am convinced that neither death, nor life...will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is *in Christ Jesus* our Lord.

Gal. 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

Phil. 3:8-9 Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For His sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ and be found *in Him*, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Christ, 2 Cor. 5:20 For our sake He made Him to be sin who knew no sin, so that *in Him* we might become the righteousness of God.

1 Cor. 1:30 And because of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, righteousness and sanctification and redemption,

Jn. 15:4 Abide *in Me*, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in Me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing.

- Rom. 14:8 For if we live, we live to the Lord, and if we die, we die to the Lord. So then, whether we live or whether we die, we are the Lord's.
- Rev. 14:3 And I heard a voice from heaven saying, "Write this: Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on."
- Col. 3:1-2 Therefore if/since you have been raised up with Christ, keep seeking the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your mind on the things above, not on the things that are on earth.
- Heb. 10:14 For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified.
- Rom. 8:29 For those whom He foreknew, He also *predestined to become conformed* to the image of His Son, so that He would be the firstborn among many brethren and these whom He predestined, He also called; and these whom He called, He also justified; and these whom He justified, He also glorified.
- 1 Thes. 5:23 Now may the God of peace *Himself sanctify you entirely*; and may your spirit and soul and body be preserved complete, without blame at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 2 Cor. 3:18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit.
- Col. 1:29 For this purpose also I labor, striving according to His power, which mightily works within me.
- 2 Pt. 1:3-6 His divine power has given to us *all things that pertain to life and godliness*, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises ...But *also for this very reason*, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue, to virtue knowledge, to knowledge self-control...
- Lk. 8:23 But as they were sailing along He fell asleep; and a fierce gale of wind descended on the lake, and they began to be swamped and to be in danger. They came to Jesus and woke Him up, saying, "Master, Master, we are perishing!" And He got up and rebuked the wind and the surging waves, and they stopped, and it became calm. And He said to them, "Where is your faith?"
- 2 Pt. 1:1 Simon Peter, a bond-servant and apostle of Jesus Christ, To those who have *received a faith* of the same kind as ours, by the righteousness of our God and Savior, Jesus Christ
- Phil. 1:29 For to you it has been granted for Christ's sake, not only to believe in Him, but also to suffer for His sake
- Acts 3:16 And on the basis of faith in His name, it is the name of Jesus which has strengthened this man whom you see and know; and the *faith which comes through Him* has given him this perfect health in the presence of you all.
- Heb. 12:1 Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith,
- Jn. 6:28 Therefore they said to Him, "What shall we do, so that we may work the works of God?" Jesus answered and said to them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He has sent." So they said to Him, "What then do You do for a sign, so that we may see, and believe You? What work do You perform?
- Heb. 4:16 Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.
