Wives are not being called to be less than their husbands but more like		
Ekklessia: We're always going to look weird to somebody.

*The wife's position as submitting to her husband as head does nothing to change her status as image bearer, helper, completer, equal in all ways. Just like Jesus' submission to the Father did nothing to change His equality with God.

Guide-Principles over practices.

How is the church subject to Christ?

- -In great faith.
- -In great humility
- -With a good

The irreducible truth of v. 24

But as the church is subject to Christ, so also the wives ought to be to their husbands in everything.

<u>The universal truth</u>. These directives, these callings are not based on gender psychology but Christ exalting theology.

Why do women push back? Why is it guys don't?

The ultimate/beautiful truth...for everyone. The catchall/release all valve

23 For the husband is the head of the wife, as Christ also is the head of the church, *He Himself being the Savior of the body.*

Catchall.

Release all.

25 Husbands, love (imperative) your (exclusive) wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her, 26 so that He might sanctify (make holy) her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, 27 that He might present to Himself the church in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be holy and blameless. 28 So husbands ought also to love their own wives as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself; 29 for no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ also does the church, 30 because we are members of His body. 31 For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and shall be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh. 32 This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church.

What does this mean? That there is unity and equality in our salvation stance. Unity doesn't mean uniformity. Equalit of position by faith doesn't imply or demand sameness in practice of that faith. What is the man asked to do? Answer:	у
