## **Ephesians Scripture Week Thirty-Three**

Acts 20:28 Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood. I know that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; and from among your own selves men will arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after them. Therefore be on the alert, remembering that night and day for a period of three years I did not cease to admonish each one with tears. And now I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified.

Jn. 10:27 My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me; and I give eternal life to them, and they will *never perish*; and *no one* will snatch them out of My hand. My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand. I and the Father are one."

- Col. 2:14 He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our transgressions, having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross. When He had disarmed the rulers (arche) and authorities (exousia), He made a public display of them, having triumphed over them through Him.
- 2 Cor. 2:14 But thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession (causes us to triumph), and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of Him everywhere.
- 1 Cor. 15:57 But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
- Rev. 2:25 Nevertheless what you have, hold fast until I come. He who overcomes, and he who keeps My deeds until the end, to him I will give authority (exousia) over the nations; and he shall rule them with a rod of iron, as the vessels of the potter are broken to pieces, as I also have received authority from My Father...
- Jn. 16:33 I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world.
- 1 Jn. 4:3 and every spirit that does not confess Jesus is not from God; this is the spirit of the antichrist, of which you have heard that it is coming, and now it is already in the world. You are from God, little children, and have overcome them; because greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world.
- Jn. 1:5 The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.
- Col. 1:29 For this purpose also I labor, striving according to His power, which mightily works within me.
- 1 Cor. 16:8-9 But I will remain in Ephesus until Pentecost; for a wide door for effective service has opened to me, and there are many adversaries.
- Mat. 11:12 From the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and violent ones take it/seize it by force.
- 1 Cor. 6:18 Flee immorality. Every other sin that a man commits is outside the body, but the immoral man sins against his own body.
- 1 Cor. 10:14 Therefore, my beloved, flee from idolatry.

Acts 7:55 But being full of the Holy Spirit, he gazed intently into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God;

Acts 26:22 So, having obtained help from God, I stand to this day testifying both to small and great, stating nothing but what the Prophets and Moses said was going to take place;

Ps. 2:8 Ask of Me, and I will surely give the nations as Your inheritance, and the very ends of the earth as Your possession.

Rom. 13:12 The night is almost gone, and the day is near. Therefore let us lay aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light. Let us behave properly as in the day, not in carousing and drunkenness, not in sexual promiscuity and sensuality, not in strife and jealousy. But **put on the Lord Jesus Christ**, and make no provision for the flesh in regard to its lusts.

Isa. 11:4 And He will strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, and with the breath of His lips He will slay the wicked. Also righteousness will be the belt about His loins, and faithfulness the belt about His waist.

Isa. 59:16 And He saw that there was no man, and was astonished that there was no one to intercede; then His own arm brought salvation to Him, and His righteousness upheld Him.

He put on righteousness like a breastplate, and a helmet of salvation on His head; and He put on garments of vengeance for clothing and wrapped Himself with zeal as a mantle.

Ex. 14:13 But Moses said to the people, "Do not fear! Stand by and see the salvation of the Lord which He will accomplish for you today; for the Egyptians whom you have seen today, you will never see them again forever. The Lord will fight for you while you keep silent."

Deut. 1:29 Then I said to you, 'Do not be shocked, nor fear them. The Lord your God who goes before you will Himself fight on your behalf, just as He did for you in Egypt before your eyes, and in the wilderness where you saw how the Lord your God carried you, just as a man carries his son....

1 Sam. 17:45 This day the Lord will deliver you up into my hands, and I will strike you down and remove your head from you.. that all this assembly may know that the Lord does not deliver by sword or by spear; for the battle is the Lord's and He will give you into our hands."

2 Chron. 20 Y ou need not fight in this battle; station yourselves, stand and see the salvation of the Lord on your behalf, O Judah and Jerusalem.' Do not fear or be dismayed; tomorrow go out to face them, for the Lord is with you."

Prov. 21:31 The horse is prepared for the day of battle, but victory belongs to the Lord.

2 Kings 6:16 Do not fear, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them." Then Elisha prayed and said, "O Lord, I pray, open his eyes that he may see." And the Lord opened the servant's eyes and he saw; and behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha.

Jude 1:24 Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to make you stand in the presence of His glory blameless with great joy,

1 Pt. 1:13 Therefore, gird up the loins of your mind for action, keep sober in spirit, fix your hope completely on the grace to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

- Jn. 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.
- Jn. 14:16 I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be with you forever; that is the *Spirit of truth*, whom the world cannot receive, because it does not see Him or know Him, but you know Him because He abides with you and will be in you.
- 1 Jn. 5:20 And we know that the Son of God has come, and has given us understanding so that we may know Him who is true; and we are in Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and eternal life.
- Jn. 17:16 They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth.
- 1 Tim. 3:15 but in case I am delayed, I write so that you will know how one ought to conduct himself in the household of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and support of the truth.
- Eph. 4:23 and that you be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and put on the new self, which in the likeness of God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the *truth*. Therefore, laying aside falsehood, speak truth each one of you with his neighbor, for we are members of one another.
- -It needs to be real, from the inside out.
- Ps. 51:6 Behold, You desire truth in the innermost being, and in the hidden part You will make me know wisdom.
- Isa. 64:6 For all of us have become like one who is unclean, And all our righteous deeds are like a filthy garment.
- 1 Cor. 1:30 But by His doing you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification, and redemption,
- 2 Cor. 5:21 He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.
- Rom. 4:4 Now to the one who works, his wage is not credited as a favor, but as what is due. But to the one who does not work, but *believes in Him* who justifies the ungodly, his *faith is credited as righteousness*,
- Rom. 8:1 Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus... 33 Who will bring a charge against God's elect? God is the one who justifies; who is the one who condemns? Christ Jesus is He who died, yes, rather who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who also intercedes for us.
- Phil. 3:9 I consider them (my accomplishments) garbage, that I may gain Christ and be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ—the *righteousness that comes from God on the basis of faith*.
- Isa. 9:6 For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
- Rom. 5:1 Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,
- Jn. 14:27 Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful.
- Col. 3:15 Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body; and be thankful

Isa. 26:12 LORD, you establish/ordain peace for us; all that we have accomplished you have done for us.

Rom. 16:20 The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. The grace of our Lord Jesus be with you.

Isa. 52:6 Therefore My people shall know My name; therefore in that day I am the One who is speaking, 'Here I am.'" How lovely on the mountains are the feet of him who brings good news, who announces peace and brings good news of happiness, who announces salvation, and says to Zion, "Your God reigns!"

Rev. 12:11 for the accuser of our brethren has been thrown down, he who accuses them before our God day and night. And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony, and they did not love their life even when faced with death.

Ex. 12:11 Now you shall eat it in this manner: with your loins girded, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and you shall eat it in haste—it is the Lord's Passover. For I will go through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike down all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgments—I am the Lord. The blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you live; and when I see the blood I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt. Now this day will be a memorial to you, and you shall celebrate it as a feast to the Lord; throughout your generations you are to celebrate it as a permanent ordinance.

Gen. 15:1 After these things the word of the Lord came to Abram in a vision: "Fear not, Abram, I am your shield; your reward shall be very great."

2 Sam. 22:31 "As for God, His way is blameless; the word of the Lord is tested; He is a shield to all who take refuge in Him.

Rom. 8:35 Who will separate us from the love of Christ? Will tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? Just as it is written,

"For Your sake we are being put to death all day long;

We were considered as sheep to be slaughtered."

But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
