Feast of Trumpets Rosh Hashanah	Trumpets used to call all the people together in preparation for the fall feasts. Lord descended on Mt. Sinai with a trumpet blast. Lost sheep called with a trumpet. Slaves freed to trumpet blasts on Jubilee, prophesied to mark the coming of Messiah	1 Thes. 4:16 For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. Day of Atonement Yom Kippur	Day of fasting and great humility A great number of sacrifices made Scapegoat thing Blood is placed on the mercy seat by the high priest in hopes of attaining the mercy of God and averting His wrath	Great day of judgment to come. Rev. 6:15-17 Rev. 11:18-19 Is. 2:19
Feast of Tabernacles/Boothes Succoth Ingathering/Harvest	Build and live in open air huts to mark dependence on the Lord. Celebration of the final fall harvest. This feast is mandatory.	Final gathering of all God's elect. Hag. 2:1-7 Jn. 7:37-38 Zech. 14:1-9, 16-19
