

Ruth Scripture Week Fourteen

Mk. 7:37 People were overwhelmed with amazement. “He has done everything well (morally right),” they said.

Jn. 7:20 “My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me...²⁴ “Father, I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you have given me because you loved me before the creation of the world.

Rom. 8:34 Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised—who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us.

2 Cor. 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.

Gal. 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

Ezek. 36:25 Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols. Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. *I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes*, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances.

Rom. 8:7 because the mind set on the flesh is hostile toward God; for it does not subject itself to the law of God, for it is not even able to do so, and those who are in the flesh *cannot please* God. *However*, you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you...¹⁴ For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.

Gal. 3:26 For in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God, through faith.

Mat. 3:16 After being baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened, and He saw the Spirit of God descending as a dove and lighting on Him, and behold, a voice out of the heavens said, “This is My beloved Son, in whom **I am well-pleased.**”

Gal. 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

Eph. 2:10 For we are *His workmanship*, created in Christ Jesus for good works,

Phil. 1:6 For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work among you will complete it by the day of Christ Jesus.

Rom. 12:1 Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God’s mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and *pleasing to God*—this is your true and proper worship.

Zeph. 3:17 The Lord your God is in your midst, a warrior Who saves. He will exult over you with joy, He will be quiet in His love, He will rejoice over you with shouts of joy.

Ps. 147:10 He does not delight in the strength of the horse; He does not take pleasure in the legs of a man. The Lord delights/enjoys/takes pleasure in those who fear Him, those who hope for His lovingkindness (*chesed*/grace).

Prov. 3:11 The Lord reproves him whom He loves, as a father the son in whom He delights.

Rom 5:5 And hope does not put us to shame, because *God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit*, who has been given to us.

Isa. 53:3 He was despised and forsaken of men, a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief; and like one from whom men hide their face He was despised, and we did not esteem Him. Surely our griefs He Himself bore, and our sorrows He carried; Yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, and by His scourging we are healed.

Mat. 26:67 Then they spat in His face and beat Him with their fists; and others slapped Him, and said, "Prophecy to us, You Christ; who is the one who hit You?"

Mat. 27:28 They stripped Him and put a scarlet robe on Him. And after twisting together a crown of thorns, they put it on His head, and a reed in His right hand; and they knelt down before Him and mocked Him, saying, "Hail, King of the Jews!" They spat on Him, and took the reed and began to beat Him on the head.

2 Cor. 5:21 For our sake he made Him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God.

Heb. 12:12 Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people through His own blood, suffered outside the gate. So, let us go out to Him outside the camp, *bearing His reproach*. For here we do not have a lasting city, but we are seeking the city which is to come.

Heb. 12:1 Therefore, since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us also lay aside every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who *for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God*.

Phil. 4:19 And my God shall supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

Eph. 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ... 8 I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints....

Ps. 27:14 Wait for the Lord; Be strong and let your heart take courage; Yes, wait for the Lord.

Ps. 130 Out of the depths I have cried to You, O LORD. Lord, hear my voice!...5 I wait for the Lord, my soul does wait, and in His word do I hope. My soul waits for the LORD more than the watchmen for the morning; indeed, more than the watchmen for the morning.

Ps. 4:1 Answer me when I call, O God of my righteousness! You have relieved me in my distress; be gracious to me and hear my prayer. O sons of men, how long will my honor become a reproach? How long will you love what is worthless and aim at deception? Selah. But know that the LORD has set apart the godly man for Himself; the LORD hears when I call to Him.

4 Tremble, and do not sin; meditate in your heart upon your bed and be still. Selah.
Offer the sacrifices of righteousness, and **trust in the LORD**.

6. Many are saying, “Who will show us any good?” Lift up the light of Your countenance upon us, O LORD! 7. You have put gladness in my heart, more than when their grain and new wine abound.

8. In peace I will both lie down **and sleep**, for **You alone, O LORD**, make me to dwell in safety (a place of assurance, hope, trust).

Ps. 40:1 I waited patiently for the LORD; and He inclined to me and heard my cry. He brought me up out of the pit of destruction, out of the miry clay, and He set my feet upon a rock making my footsteps firm. He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God; many will see and fear and will trust in the LORD. How blessed is the man who has made the LORD his trust...

Ps. 40:12 For evils beyond number have surrounded me; my iniquities have overtaken me, so that I am not able to see; they are more numerous than the hairs of my head, and my heart has failed me. Be pleased, O LORD, to deliver me; make haste, O LORD, to help me...17 You are my help and my deliverer; do not delay, O my God.

Isa. 40:28 Do you not know? Have you not heard? The Everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth does not become weary or tired. His understanding is inscrutable. He gives strength to the weary, and to him who lacks might He increases power. Though youths grow weary and tired, and vigorous young men stumble badly, yet those who wait for the LORD will gain their strength; they will mount up with wings like eagles, they will run and not get weary they will walk and not become faint.

2 Cor. 12:8 Concerning this thing I pleaded with the Lord three times that it might depart from me. And He said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ’s sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

Jn. 14:16 And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever— the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. I will not leave you orphans; *I will come to you*.

Eph. 1:13 In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise, Who is given as a *pledge of our inheritance*, with a view to the redemption of God’s own possession, to the praise of His glory.

Rom.8:23 And not only this, but also we ourselves, having the first fruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting eagerly for our adoption as sons, the redemption of our body. For in hope we have been saved, but hope that is seen is not hope; for who hopes for what he already sees? But if we hope for what we do not see, with perseverance we wait eagerly for it.

2 Cor. 4:18 while we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen; for the things which are seen are temporal, but the things which are not seen are eternal.

Ps. 62: My soul, wait in silence for God only, for my hope is from Him. He only is my rock and my salvation, my stronghold; I shall not be shaken. On God my salvation and my glory rest; the rock of my strength, my refuge is in God.

Josh. 23:14 “Now behold, today I am going the way of all the earth, and you know in all your hearts and in all your souls that not one word of all the good words which the LORD your God spoke concerning you has failed (naphal); all have been fulfilled for you, not one of them has failed (naphal).
