Ruth Scripture Week Fifteen

- 2 Cor. 5:14 For the love of Christ controls/compels us, having concluded this, that one died for all, therefore all died: and He died for all, so that they who live might no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and rose again on their behalf.
- Rom. 8:3 For what the law could not do, weak as it was through the flesh, God did sending His only son
- Acts 4:12 And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved
- Josh 1:2 Now it came about after the death of Moses the servant of the Lord that the Lord spoke to Joshua son on Nun, Moses' servant, saying, "Moses my servant is dead. Arise therefore, cross the Jordan, you and all this people, to the land I am giving them to the sons of Israel. Every place on which the sole of your foot treads I have given it to you, just as I spoke to Moses.
- 1 Kngs. 18:21 Elijah came near to all the people and said, "How long will you hesitate(limp about) between two opinions? If the Lord is God, follow Him; but if Baal, him." But the people did not answer him a word.
- Mat. 5:17 Do no think that I came to destroy the law or the prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill. For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled. Whoever therefore breaks one of the least of these commandments and teaches men so, shall he be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever does and teaches them, he shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven. For I say to you, that unless your righteousness exceeds that of the righteousness of the scribes and pharisees, you will by no means enter the kingdom. of heaven.
- Col. 2:14 by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands. This He set aside nailing it to the cross.
- Rom. 8:3 For what the law could not do, weak as it was through the flesh, God did. Offering His own son in the likeness of sinful flesh, He condemned sin in the flesh, so that the requirement of the law would be fulfilled in us who no longer walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.
- Rom. 8:1 Therefore, there is now no condemnation for thos who are in Christ Jesus for the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and death.
- Gal. 2:16 knowing that a person is not justified by works of the law but by faith In Christ Jesus, even we have believed in Christ Jesus so that we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, since by works of the law no flesh is justified.
- Gal. 6:2 Bear one another's burden and thereby fulfill the law of Christ.
- Jn. 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being.
- Heb. 1:3 And He is the radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature, and upholds all things by the word of His power.

Col. 1:16 For by Him all things were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created through Him and for Him. He is before all things, and in Him all things together.

Lk. 1:53 And has exalted those who were humble. He has filled the hungry with good things;

Phil. 2:6 Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

Mat. 27:22 Pilate said to them, "Then what shall I do with Jesus who is called Christ?" *They all* said, "Crucify Him!" And he said, "Why, what evil has He done?" But they kept shouting all the more, saying, "Crucify Him!"

Acts 4:27 For truly in this city there were gathered together against Your holy servant Jesus, whom You anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, along with the Gentiles and the peoples of Israel,

Heb. 13:12 Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people through His own blood, suffered outside the gate.

Heb. 2:10 For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things, and through whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to perfect the author of their salvation through sufferings. For both He who sanctifies and those who are sanctified are all from one Father; for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren....

Mat. 9:10 While Jesus was having dinner at Matthew's house, many tax collectors and sinners came and ate with him and his disciples. When the Pharisees saw this, they asked his disciples, "Why does your teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?" On hearing this, Jesus said, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. But go and learn what this means: 'I desire mercy, not sacrifice.

Lk. 23:33 When they came to the place called The Skull, there they crucified Him and the criminals, one on the right and the other on the left.

Rev. 5:9 Worthy are You to take the book and to break its seals; for You were slain, and purchased for God with Your blood men from every tribe and tongue and people and nation.

Gal. 6:15 For neither circumcision counts for anything, nor uncircumcision, but a new creation.

1 Jn. 3:1 See what kind of love the Father has given to us, that we should be called children of God; and so we are.

Gal. 3:13 Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us—for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree"—

Tit. 2:14 Who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works.

Heb. 9:12 He entered once for all into the holy places, not by means of the blood of goats and calves but by means of his own blood, thus securing an eternal redemption.

Rev. 11:15 Then the seventh angel sounded: And there were loud voices in heaven, saying, 'The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever!'

Dan. 7:18 But the saints of the Most High will receive the kingdom and will possess it forever — yes, for ever and ever.

Acts 2:8 And how is it that we each hear them in our own language to which we were born? Parthians and Medes and Elamites, and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the districts of Libya around Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, both Jews and *proselytes*, Cretans and Arabs—we hear them in our own tongues speaking of the mighty deeds of God."…17 And it shall be in the last days, 'God says, 'That I will pour forth of My Spirit on all mankind;… 41 So then, those who had received his word were baptized; and that day there were added about three thousand souls.

Eph. 2:12 remember that you were at that time separate from Christ, excluded from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus you who formerly were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ... So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and *are of God's household*,

Eph. 5:31 For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and shall be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh. This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to *Christ and the church*.

Eph. 5:25-26 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her, so that He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, that He might present to Himself the church in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be holy and blameless.

Jn. 14:1-3 Do not let your heart be troubled; believe in God, believe also in Me. In My Father's house are many dwelling places; if it were not so, I would have told you; for I go to prepare a place for you. If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself, that where I am, there you may be also.

1 Thes. 4:16 For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a [m]shout, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain will be caught up (take for oneself) together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we shall always be with the Lord.

Rev. 19:7 Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to Him, for the marriage of the Lamb has come and His bride has made herself ready."

Eph. 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ

Jn. 1:12 To all who received, to those who believe in his name, he gave the right to become children of God — children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God.

1 Pt. 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to obtain an inheritance which is imperishable and undefiled and will not fade away, reserved in heaven for you

Dan 12:1 Now at that time Michael, the gret prince who stand guard over the sons of our people, will arise, and there will be atime of distress such as never occurrd since there was a ntion until that time; and at that time your

people, everyone who is found written in the book, will be rescued. Many of those who sleep in the dust of the ground will awake, these to everlasting life, but the others to disgrace and everlasting contempt. Those who have insight will shine brightly like the brightness of the expanse of heaven, and those who lead the many to righteousness, like the stars forever and ever.

Rev. 3:5 He who overcomes shall be clothed in white garments, and I will not blot out his name from the Book of Life; but will confess his name before My Father and before His angels.
